
PRIVACY POLICY

The TP TOUR, the owner and provider of this web site applies this privacy policy for terms and conditions of the use of data collected by us in relation to use of the web site and any services or systems therein.

1. **Definitions and Interpretation**

In this Policy the following terms shall have the following meanings:

“Account”	Information and credentials used by Users to access Material and / or any communications System on the Web Site;
“Content”	Text, graphics, images, audio, video, software, data compilations and any other form of information capable of being stored in a computer that appears on or forms part of this Web Site;
“Data”	Information that you submit to us. This includes, but is not limited to, details and information submitted using any of our Services or Systems;
“Service”	Online facilities, tools, services or information that the TP TOUR makes available through the Web Site with our software provider BLUE GOLF
“Web Site”	(www.tptourseries.com) and any sub-domains of this site unless expressly excluded by their own terms and conditions.

2. **Data Collected**

The following Data may be collected:

- 2.1 name;
- 2.2 gender;
- 2.3 contact information such as email addresses and telephone numbers;
- 2.4 demographic information such as post code, preferences and interests;
- 2.5 payment information bank account sort code account number and name
- 2.6 IP address (automatically collected);
- 2.7 web browser type and version (automatically collected);
- 2.8 operating system (automatically collected); and
- 2.9 Cookie information (see Clause 10 below).

3. **Our Use of Data**

- 3.1 Any personal Data you submit will be retained by TP TOUR and BLUE GOLF the software provider for as long as you use the services and systems provided when you register. Data that you may submit through any

communications system that we may provide can be retained for a period of up to 6 months.

- 3.2 Your Data will not be disclosed to third parties unless consent is given by you directly. This includes our affiliates and / or other companies and partners.
- 3.3 All personal Data is stored securely in accordance with the principles of the Data Protection Act 1998.
- 3.4 Data may be used by us for the following reasons:
 - 3.4.1 internal record keeping
 - 3.4.2 improvement of our products and services
 - 3.4.3 transmission by email of information relevant to the activities involved
 - 3.4.4 Market research purposes which may be via email, telephone, or by mail.

4. Controlling Access to your Data

- 4.1 Wherever you are required to submit Data, you will be given options to restrict our use of that Data

5. Your Right to Withhold Information

- 5.1 You may access the Web Site without providing any Data at all. However, to use all Services and Systems available on the Web Site you may be required to submit some personal information, this is restricted to telephone number and email. Other information you may provide voluntarily.

You may restrict your internet browser's use of Cookies

6. Accessing your own Data

- 6.1 You may access your account at any time to view or amend the Data. You may need to modify or update your Data if your circumstances change. Additional Data as to your marketing preferences may also be stored and you may change this at any time.

7. Security

8. Cookies
